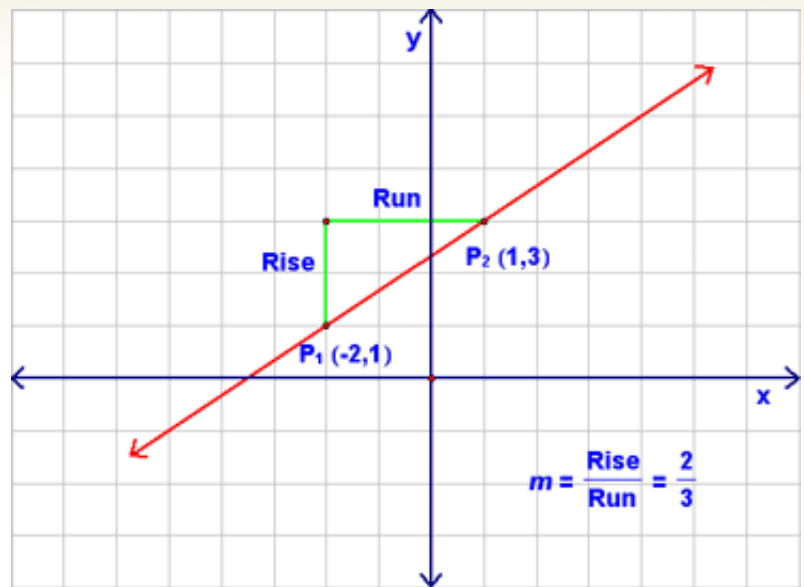

# What if you are late to class?

## Excused

- Valid pass

## Unexcused

- No pass
- Sign the clipboard
- > 10 minutes = Skipping
  
- 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> tardy = Detention (20 mins)
- 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> tardy = Detention (60 mins)
- 10<sup>th</sup> tardy = ISS (2 days)
- >10 tardies = ISS (3days)

# Tissue

# Passing in papers
